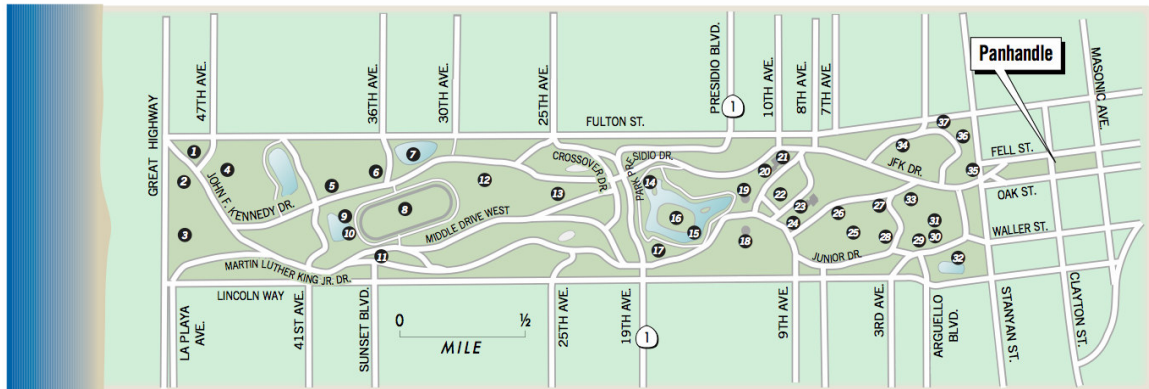
Dates and Times

Park and Festival Location

Golden Gate Park in San Francisco

Getting To The Festival

NOTE: Extremely limited parking inside the park and in surrounding neighborhoods, we encourage you to take public or alternative means of transportation.

Public Transportation (outside San Francisco)

Coming From The East Bay

- Option 1

1. Take BART to Powell Station (rates vary from location)
2. From Powell & Market, take Muni Bus #5 to 25th & Fulton
3. Enter the Park

- Option 2

1. Take the AC Transit Transbay Express or F Line across the Bay Bridge
2. At Transbay Terminal, take Muni Bus #5 to 25th and Fulton (\$1.50)
3. Enter the Park

From The North Bay

- Option 1

1. Take Golden Gate Transit Bus #70/80 to Golden Gate Bridge Toll Plaza
2. Board Muni Bus #28
3. The 28 will take you into Golden Gate Park.

- Option 2

1. Larkspur Ferry/Sausalito Ferry to SF Ferry Building
2. Walk along Market to Metro Embarcadero Station.

3. Take Muni Line N to 19th and Judah (\$1.50)
4. Walk North on 19th to Golden Gate Park.

From The South Bay

• Option 1

1. Take Caltrain to San Francisco Station (the end of the line)
2. Take Muni Line N to 19th and Judah (\$1.50)
3. Walk North on 19th to Golden Gate Park.

By Bicycle

Enter the park at the 30th ave and Fulton entrance. Make a left and you will see Marks Meadow where you can park your bike.

The San Francisco Bicycle Coalition will be providing complimentary Valet Bike Parking service at Golden Gate Park. Think of it like a coat check for bikes—you don't need to worry about the safety of your bike while you are out enjoying the music, just park your bike in the morning and then turn in your claim check when you're heading home. Additional bike racks will be set up around the park for you if you bring your own lock.

By Foot

If you are entering the park from the South, you can enter at 25th avenue and Lincoln. Go to your left and bear right onto Middle drive. There, you will be able to access the South gate of the festival. You can also enter at 19th avenue and Lincoln and crossover on Transverse drive to Speedway Meadows. This will also take you to the South Gate of the Festival.

If you are entering the park from the North, you can enter at 30th avenue and Fulton and enter straight into Lindley Meadow. You can also enter on 36th avenue and Fulton and enter at the North gate by the Polo Field.

What You Can Bring

- Blankets
- Stadium seats
- Soft-sided coolers
- Regular-size/unframed backpacks
- Two factory-sealed water bottles up to 1 liter each
- Empty Camelbak or other empty plastic container (ie, Nalgene bottle)
- Ice in soft-sided cooler or Camelbak. No large bags allowed.
- Binoculars
- Personal cameras (i.e. small digital cameras or point-and-click 35mm cameras). Cameras with any type of detachable lenses are prohibited.

What You Can't Bring

- Weapons of any kind
- Illegal substances or drug paraphernalia
- Framed or large backpacks
- Alcohol (alcohol will be sold at the Festival)
- Glass containers of ANY kind
- Food or beverages, except for factory-sealed water bottles
- Skateboards, scooters, or personal motorized vehicles
- Bicycles inside Festival grounds (bike racks are available Marks Meadow)
- Fireworks
- Explosives
- Instruments
- Laser Pointers
- Umbrellas
- Strollers
- Picnic Baskets
- Non-collapsible or collapsible chairs
- Lawn Furniture
- Large or Hard-sided coolers
- Tents
- Pets (except service dogs)
- Video equipment: No video recording will be allowed.

- Professional still camera equipment (no detachable lenses, no tripods, big zooms, or commercial use rigs)
- Audio recording equipment
- No illegal vending is permitted. No unauthorized/unlicensed vendors allowed.

Access Options

Service animals trained to assist disabled persons will be allowed into the festival. There will be a raised platform viewing area for persons with disabilities. One companion is allowed onto the platform area.

Food Options

Reasonably priced food (including vegetarian/vegan options) and drinks will be available on-site. More information about the food vendors and options will be released in upcoming weeks.

Security/Safety

Our primary goal is to create a safe and secure environment for all festival attendees. To ensure this, there will be on-site security provided by local police and private security companies. If you are experiencing any problems whatsoever, locate a festival staff member, security guard, or police officer.

Medical

Rock Medicine will be on-site to help you with any type of medical problem. If you need assistance, go to the medical tent, or look for a police officer or Festival staff member. Rock Medicine has been providing medical services at concerts for 35 years.

Lost and Found

If you lost something while at the festival, check with the Lost and Found, which will be located inside the Information Booth. The Information Booth will be marked on the map you receive when entering the festival.

ATMs

There will be a number of ATMs located at the festival. Their locations will be marked on the map you receive when you enter the site.
